

331 CURRICULUM GUIDES

Instructional goals and objectives and course outlines shall be prepared by the professional staff consistent with state law, the Mission Statement of the School District, Board goals and objectives and approved academic standards.

Where possible, a student will be taught at his/her level of need and will not repeat that which he/she already knows.

The Superintendent, and through him/her, the curriculum and instruction program staff, and building administration, shall have general coordinating authority and supervision over the formation of all courses of study and instructional objectives.
