

832 WEAPONS ON SCHOOL PREMISES

No individual shall possess or use a dangerous weapon in school buildings, on school premises, in a District-owned vehicle or at any school-sponsored function or event. A dangerous weapon is defined as a firearm (loaded or unloaded), knife, razor, martial arts device, explosive device, metal knuckle, or any other object, which is used or intended to be used to inflict bodily harm.

Students who violate this policy shall be referred to law enforcement officials and shall be subject to school disciplinary action, including suspension and/or expulsion, in accordance with state and federal laws and Board policies. The student's parent(s)/guardian shall also be notified.

Students with disabilities who are in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline consistent with the provisions of Section 504 and the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

Individuals who violate this policy, who are not students, shall be referred to law enforcement officials and shall be subject to state and federal laws.
