## **Academic Eligibility** (Updated Fall of 2010 for WRPS Activities Code)

9<sup>th</sup> Grade – 12<sup>th</sup> grade participants in WRPS Co-Curricular programs should be continually striving to achieve their full potential in areas of academic performance and academic attendance. In order to participate in competitions and public events, each participant/student-athlete must maintain acceptable academic standards.

- Eligibility requirements shall commence upon initial enrollment in the first cocurricular activity
- A student must satisfy WRPS and DPI requirements defining a full time student
- <u>Semester One Junior High and LHS</u>: Each 9<sup>th</sup> grade 12<sup>th</sup> grade co-curricular participant receiving two F's in Progress Report #1 (6 weeks), Progress Report #2 (12 weeks) or the formal evaluation period of the First Semester shall be deemed ineligible for participation in competition and public events.

## o <u>Ineligibility Periods:</u>

- Progress Report #1(6 weeks) Beginning the second day after all grades are posted, individuals with 2 or more F's are ineligible for 5 formal school days. On the 4th day a Student Eligibility Form (SEF) must be taken to teachers to chart updated academic progress. If the SEF shows no more than 1 F an individual is eligible beginning the 6th day. If grades show 2 F's or more, an individual remains ineligible for another 5 formal school days and then can take the SEF to teachers. This pattern continues until no more than 1 F is identified on the SEF. (The SEF may only be given to teachers once per week.)
- Progress Report #2 (12 weeks) Same 2 F rule but students will be ineligible for 10 formal school days beginning the second day after grades are posted. On the 9th day a Student Eligibility Form may be taken to teachers. If no more than 1 F is reported, eligibility is granted on the 11<sup>th</sup> day. If not, 5 more days must pass before the once-weekly SEF may be passed again to teachers.
- First Semester The process is similar to Progress Reports but individuals with 2 or more F's are ineligible for 15 formal school days beginning the second day after the posting of First Semester grades. On the 14<sup>th</sup> day individuals may take the SEF to teachers. Eligibility may be granted beginning the 16<sup>th</sup> day. If 2 F's remain, the once weekly pattern of an SEF to teachers will continue until a maximum of 1 F is listed.
- <u>Semester Two Junior High and LHS:</u> Each 9<sup>th</sup> grade 12<sup>th</sup> grade co-curricular participant receiving two F's in Progress Report #3 (24 weeks), Progress Report #4 (30 weeks) and the formal evaluation period of the Second Semester shall be deemed ineligible for participation in competition and public events.

## o <u>Ineligibility Periods:</u>

Progress Report #3(24 weeks) – Beginning the second day after all grades are posted, individuals with 2 or more F's are ineligible for 5 formal school days. On the 4th day a Student Eligibility Form

- (SEF) must be taken to teachers to chart updated academic progress. If the SEF shows no more than 1 F an individual is eligible beginning the 6th day. If grades show 2 F's or more, an individual remains ineligible for another 5 formal school days and once again can take the SEF to teachers. This pattern continues until no more than 1 F is identified on the SEF. (The SEF may only be given to teachers once per week.)
- <u>Progress Report #4</u> (30 weeks) Same 2 F rule but students will be ineligible for 10 formal school days beginning on the second day after grades are posted. On the 9th day a SEF may be taken to teachers. If no more than 1 F is reported then eligibility is granted; if not, 5 more days must pass before the once-weekly SEF may be passed again to teachers.
- Second Semester Individuals with 2 or more F's are ineligible for 21 calendar days beginning the first day of their respective Fall sport's first official day of practice. On the 19<sup>th</sup> day individuals may take the SEF to teachers. Eligibility may be granted beginning the 22nd day or, if 2 F's remain, the once weekly pattern of an SEF to teachers will continue until a maximum of 1 F or less is listed.

\*Each time a 9<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> grader still has 2 F's or more after an initial ineligibility of 5, 10, or 15 days, and 21 calendar days(from first day of practice for an individual's respective Sport in the Fall), he/she must wait another 5 days before taking another Student Evaluation Form (SEF) to teachers.
