**NO EXCEPTIONS**

1. Each student athlete must have a current completed WIAA Sports Physical Card on file at Lincoln High School. Note: Physical examination taken April 1 and thereafter is valid for the following two school years; physical examination taken before April 1 is valid only for the remainder of that school year and the following school year.
2. WIAA Alternate Year Cards are to be completed every other year.
3. Parents and Athletes should read the Wisconsin Rapids Public Schools District Activities Code Handbook and return the completed Parent – Participant Acknowledgement and Comments for Emergency Medical Treatment form. This form needs to be signed by a parent/guardian during their first year at the junior high and their first year at the senior high.
4. Consent for Emergence Medical Treatment Card. Coaches will keep these medical cards.
5. WIAA Eligibility Information Form signed and dated by parent/guardian and student once per year.
6. Book & Material Fee. Students must be up to date on payment of their book and material fees in order to practice or participate.
