- Submit all of the above documentation to the Lincoln High School Student Services Office by March 25, 2013.
- A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to the student who best meets the scholarship criteria. This scholarship is renewable for a second year if full-time student status and a 3.0 or better grade point average are maintained.
