



## **2016 SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

Soon it will be time for the 2016 Summer School Program. As you review the course booklet, you will notice that we have added some classes as well as enhanced some courses to better provide for more "active" learning experiences. These changes and additions will offer some very exciting activities for our students. Unless noted in the book, KG-5<sup>th</sup> Grade registration, sorry no 4-K summer school classes offered.

**Unless otherwise noted in the book:**

**Session I: Monday, June 13 - Thursday, June 30.**

**Session II: July 5 - July 21 (No classes - July 1 or July 4)**

**Primary Classes ("P") KG-2nd Grades at Woodside Elementary School**

**Intermediate Classes ("I") 3rd-5th Grades will be held at Washington Elementary**

Unless otherwise noted in the summer school book, classes during each session will be held from (approximately: 8:30 am until noon) 8:30 am – 10 am and 10:15 am – 11:55 a.m. Recess: 10 -10:15 am. Washington's school buses release at 11:45 am.

Parents are requested to register students for three classes they would like to participate in for each session, please follow the instructions in the book. Every attempt will be made to ensure that students will receive two of their three courses. The district reserves the right to cancel any classes that do not have an adequate number of students registered for the course, or for which a certified teacher can not be hired.

Students at Rudolph and Vesper Elementary Schools may register through their school offices, or parents may register their children at any of the following schools listed below.

Students at Mead, Woodside, Grant & Grove, and Washington & Howe may register at any of the schools listed below:

Mead – Thursday, February 25  
Grant & Grove – Tuesday, March 1

Woodside – Friday, February 26  
Howe & Washington – Thursday, March 3

**Registration will be held from 3:45 – 5:45 p.m. with the exception of Woodside School, 3:45-6:15 p.m. to allow for Friday evening registration.** You may enroll your child at any of the schools on the date and time that is most convenient. Please Note: It is very important that you attempt to register your child during the above dates and times. We will not be able to guarantee classes and sessions if you register after March 3, 2016.

The exact times for each of the courses will not be set until after all of the registrations have been completed. Your child's schedule will be sent to their "home school" before the end of the school year.

During registration, registration cards will be collected, busing information will be recorded. At your request, a confirmation form can be given to you during the registration nights. **Parents who are unable to register their children in person may send the completed registration card with their child to their school office prior to March 8.**
