
## How To Connect to WRSGuest wireless using Vista


1. Be sure the wireless is enabled on your laptop. (In this example, after enabling the wireless card, the wireless button on this laptop will light up blue indicting the wireless card is turned on.). This may be different on each computer. If you are not sure, be sure to refer to your owner's manual.




2. Once enabled, you will need to connect to our wireless network. Start by **right clicking** the **Wireless Icon** in the system tray (located on the bottom right of the desktop).




**3.** Locate the **WRSGuest** network from the options shown, click that option and click **Connect.** 



**4.** Choose the option **Connect Anyway.** 



**5.** Click the **Close** option.



**6.** If you are connecting for the first time to the WRSGuest network, you may be prompted to select the network location. Choose the **Public Location** option.



7. Once you open your Internet browser (ie Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari) you will be redirected to a web page that requires your credentials to authenticate to a guest Internet only network.

## Please keep in mind:

- You will <u>not</u> be able to print.
- You will <u>not</u> have your home directory or other network drives mapped for you.
- You can access your network drives via Remote Access.
- You can access your email through webmail.
